HANA BANK USA COMMUNITY REINVESTMENT ACT STATEMENT

Hana Bank USA, National Association ("HBU"), formerly BNB Hana Bank, N.A., and KEB Hana Bank USA, National Association ("KEB Hana"), opened for business on September 16, 1986. Hana Bank USA is a wholly owned subsidiary of Hana Bancorp, Inc., which is owned by Hana Bank in Seoul, South Korea, a subsidiary of the Hana Financial Group. Hana Bank USA has its corporate office located at 222 Bridge Plaza South, Suite 730, Fort Lee, NJ 07024. Hana Bank USA has three (3) branch offices located in New York County and Queens County, New York; and Bergen County, New Jersey. Branch Offices provide full services, including loan and deposit products and services to businesses and consumers within the assessment areas delineated below:

Delineation of Facility-based Assessment Area

Hana Bank USA has one facility-based Assessment Area that covers eleven (11) counties located in New York and New Jersey. These counties are located within three MDs that are part of the New York-Northern New Jersey-Long Island, NY-NJ-PA Multistate Metropolitan Statistical Area (MMSA) (35620). Eight (8) counties are in the New York-White Plains-Wayne, NY-NJ MD (35614), two (2) counties in the Newark, NJ-PA MD (35084), and one (1) county in Nassau County-Suffolk County MD (35004).

1. New York

All of the Bronx County, Kings County, New York County, Queens County, Westchester County, and Nassau County have been delineated as the bank's assessment area. Hana Bank USA has two (2) branch offices in New York County and Queens County at below locations:

2. New Jersey

All of the Bergen County, Hudson County, Passaic County, Essex County, and Union County have been delineated as the bank's assessment area. Hana Bank USA has one (1) branch office in Bergen County, located at below locations:
